Frequently Asked Questions

- Is processing trees considered an agricultural activity?
No, only activities directly related to the cultivation or harvesting of trees are allowed. Processing trees is not directly related to cultivation and harvesting of trees.
- What do I do if a COE is requested from another district?
It is the district's NGS Data Specialist responsibility to send the most updated COE & Supplemental Form for the family requested. This is a collaborative effort among all our districts. Districts can send a request of COE by email or fax for documentation purposes for both districts. COEs should be sent in a timely fashion within 1 -2 days no later. If your 5 days of input into NGS is up, please remember you must supply a comment on the terminal site log.
