

Teacher Orientation and Preparation Program Application Process

Please review all program application requirements prior to submitting an application.

All applicants will need to submit application via the online system.

You will need your personal demographic and university information available while you complete the form. Please also have a certification content considered to include on the application.

Your data will be saved automatically after you complete the first section and you can return to complete information at a later date using your last name and Social Security number.

After the last section is completed you will need to “submit” the application. Until this is done you cannot be considered for admittance into the program.

Please be sure to print the verification page to use as a checklist to follow. All required documentation and fees must be submitted in order for your application to be processed.
